**ACC-NW Sunday School for November 25, 2007**  
**約書亞記第十一章 Joshua 11**

**Q1:** 敵人變得更大, 更強, 更團結, 人數更多, 也更複雜. 但我們的上帝比他們都大. 以色列人被告知不要害怕, 也不要膽怯. 當我們面臨不可逾越的挑戰時, 我們是充滿害怕呢, 還是信靠上帝? 在我們的禱告里, 我們是告訴上帝我們面臨的挑戰有多大呢, 還是告訴我們的挑戰我們的上帝有多大?

The enemies get bigger, stronger, more united, greater in number, and in sophistication. But our God is greater than them all. Israelites are told not to fear them nor be discouraged. When faced with huge mountain of challenges that are clearly impossible, do we buckle under the fear or do we put our trust in God? In our prayers, do we tell God how big our mountains are or do we tell our mountains how big is our God?

**Q2:** 為什麼神吩咐以色列人去砍斷敵人馬的蹄筋, 毀壞敵人的車輛? 這些戰爭器具有什麼不對嗎? 神要告訴以色列人的是什麼?

Why did God tell Israelites to cut off horse's hamstrings and destroy enemies chariots? Is there anything wrong with these instruments of war? What is God trying to say to the Israelites?

**Q3:** 我們可以從第 15 節學到什麼功課? 注意在從耶和華到摩西和從摩西到約書亞的權柄承接過程中, 上帝是如何做工的. 在神所設立的權柄下做工的益處是什麼? 在家庭, 教會和社區里, 神所設立的權柄綫是什麼? 我該怎麼樣應對來自權柄綫的決定和要求?

What lessons can you take away from verse 15? Notice how God works through the authority line from God to Moses and Moses to Joshua. What are the benefits of working under God's given authority? What are my God-given authority lines at home, in church, and community? How do I respond to authority line's decision and their requests of me?

**Q4:** 約書亞執行看起來不可能任務的能力是我們應當學習的. 要成為一個如此順服的神的僕人, 有什麼是約書亞必須明確知道的? 你能否概括並張開討論: 從約書亞所具有的屬神品格中, 我們有什麼可以學習的?

Joshua's ability to carry out seemingly impossible commands is something we all need to learn. What are the explicit understandings Joshua must have in order to be such an obedient servant of God? Can you outline some of Joshua's Godly characters we can learn from and expand them further on your own?

**Q5:** 第 23 節陳明了約書亞和以色列人通過用神的方法來實現神的旨意所取得的完全勝利. 在我們每日的決策制定過程中, 我們當如何應用這個原則? 試設想一個你可以應用這個原則來達到完全勝利的情境.

Verse 23 states complete victory for Joshua and the Israelites by Doing God's will on God's term using God's means. How do we apply this principle in our daily decision making process? Think of a situation or occasion where you applied this principle to achieve complete victory!
